

Rules for audience participation at auctions Pride of Poland and Summer Sale

The auction is open to the public, however, for logistical reasons, the number of people who can participate in it is limited.

- Tickets for the Auction can be purchased (PLN 50 net) via www.ebilet.pl. The number of tickets is limited!
- The audience area has seating, however tickets do not provide a dedicated seat.
- Tickets for the Auction do not entitle to attend the Polish National Arabian Horse Show. Free tickets for each day of the Polish National Arabian Horse Show can be ordered via www.ebilet.pl. The number of tickets is limited!

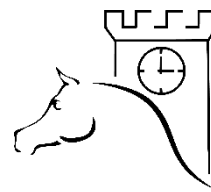
VIP INVITATIONS

- Seats in the VIP sector are available to Auction participants and persons with a personal invitation.
- Persons interested in purchasing personalized VIP tickets are asked to send an order (Name and surname, data to issue the invoice, consent to issuing the invoice electronically (attachment)), GDPR information clause, to the e-mail address: rezerwacja@pkwk.org.
- Priority in purchasing VIP invitations is given to persons paying the bid bond (it is recommended to pay the bid bond in advance to ensure participation in the Auction), then exhibitors (owners) of horses presented at the Polish National Arabian Horse Show (by 25.07.2023 latest)
- After accepting the order, an invoice will be sent in the amount corresponding to the value of the order. VIP invitations will be sent after payment is confirmed.
- Sending an order is not tantamount to its execution.
- The seat at the VIP table is indicated by the Organizer.
 - The number of places is limited. The organizer reserves the right to refuse to sell the VIP invitation without giving a reason.
 - The invitation to the Auction does not entitle to the presence in the VIP area during the Polish National Arabian Horse Show

Information clause on the processing of personal data in connection with the organized Auctions

Information about the processing of your personal data

The Polish Jockey Club (hereinafter also referred to as "PKWK") hereby informs you that it processes your personal data. Details of this processing can be found below.

1. Personal data administrator The administrator of your personal data is the Polish Jockey Club based in Warsaw.

2. Data Protection Officer PKWK has appointed a Data Protection Officer, whom you can contact in matters of protection of your personal data processed by PKWK and in matters of exercising your rights. Contact with the Data Protection Officer is possible by phone (tel. no. +48 502 201 052), by e-mail (e-mail: Ochronydanych@pkwk.org) or in writing, to the address of the PKWK seat: Warszawa (02-684), ul. Puławska 266, with the note: IOD.

3. Purposes and grounds for processing personal data a) In order to properly perform the tasks imposed on PKWK in the Act of 18 January 2001 on horse racing (Journal of Laws of 2017, item 194, as amended) and in the executive acts to this Act or in other normative acts adopted on its basis, based on your consent (the basis of Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR), b) For archival purposes (evidence) to secure information in the event of a legal need to indicate facts, which is the legitimate interest of PKWK (the basis of Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR), c) In order to possibly determine, investigate or defend against claims, which is the legitimate interest of the PKWK (the basis of Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR), d) For purposes related to the organization of the Pride of Poland Summer Sale by PKWK in 2022.

4. Recipients of personal data PKWK may share your personal data with the following entities/categories of entities: a) subcontractors, i.e. entities whose services PKWK uses to process them, such as accounting, legal, IT companies, loss adjusters, marketing agencies, etc. related to the organization of the above-mentioned auctions; b) other independent recipients, such as competent state institutions, on the basis of the relevant provisions of generally applicable law.

5. Transfer of personal data to third countries or international organizations PKWK does not transfer your personal data outside the territory of the Republic of Poland / European Union / European Economic Area.

6. Data retention period Your basic contact details are stored by the PKWK for the purposes of proper performance by the PKWK of the obligations imposed on the PKWK as the organizer of the auction, in the Horse Racing Act or resulting from the statutory objectives of the PKWK. Until you object to their processing for this purpose, you will withdraw your consent if PKWK processed them on the basis of a specific consent, or PKWK considers that these data have become outdated. If your data has been obtained by PKWK in connection with the conclusion of a contract, they are stored by PKWK until the end of the limitation period for potential claims under such a contract.

7. Your rights You have the following rights related to personal data:

a) the right to access your data and receive a copy thereof,

b) the right to rectify (correct) your data,

c) the right to delete data (if in your opinion there are no grounds for PKWK to process your data, you can request their removal),

d) restriction of data processing (you can request that PKWK limit the processing of your personal data only to their storage or performance of actions agreed with you, if in your opinion PKWK has incorrect data about you or processes it unjustifiably, or you do not want PKWK to remove it because you need them to establish, pursue or defend claims, or for the duration of your objection to data processing,

e) the right to object to data processing on the basis of a legitimate interest (i.e. conducted for purposes other than direct marketing) and when data processing is necessary for PKWK to perform a task carried out in the public interest or for PKWK to exercise public authority entrusted to PKWK. In this case, you should indicate to PKWK your special situation, which in your opinion justifies the cessation by PKWK of processing the data covered by your objection. PKWK will stop processing your personal data for these purposes, unless it proves that the grounds for processing your data override your rights or that your data is necessary for PKWK to establish, pursue or defend claims,

f) the right to transfer data: you have the right to receive from PKWK in a structured, commonly used machine-readable format (e.g. CSV format) personal data concerning you, which you provided to PKWK on the basis of a contract or your consent. You can instruct PKWK to transfer this data directly to another entity,

g) the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority: if you believe that PKWK is processing your data unlawfully, you can submit a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office or to another competent supervisory authority,

h) the right to withdraw consent to the processing of your data: you have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of data by PKWK at any time. Withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of data processing based on your consent before its withdrawal.

Please note that prior to the PKWK is required to identify your identity.

8. Information on the requirement / voluntary provision of data Providing PKWK data by you is/may be:

a) a statutory requirement resulting from the Horse Racing Act, the Labor Code;

b) a condition for concluding a contract with PKWK,

c) a contractual requirement resulting from the contract concluded by you with PKWK,

d) voluntary.

If you do not provide PKWK with personal data:

a) PKWK may refuse to conclude a contract with you, consider an application, notification, etc.,

b) PKWK may claim compensation or refuse to provide the benefit.
